

# **Cornice Nr. 102 “Cumberland”**

**(Georgian in Style)**

This cornice design has the unattractive jargon term of “drip”. This term arises from the overhanging “water nosing” feature part half way down this moulding.

There are some similar Georgian Drip designs, for instance numbers 102, 104 & 105. Consider these, also the dentil enriched 114, 131 & 143 cornice types.

Especially if you feel this slightly “above average” sized cornice moulding is Not quite the correct size for your home or project.

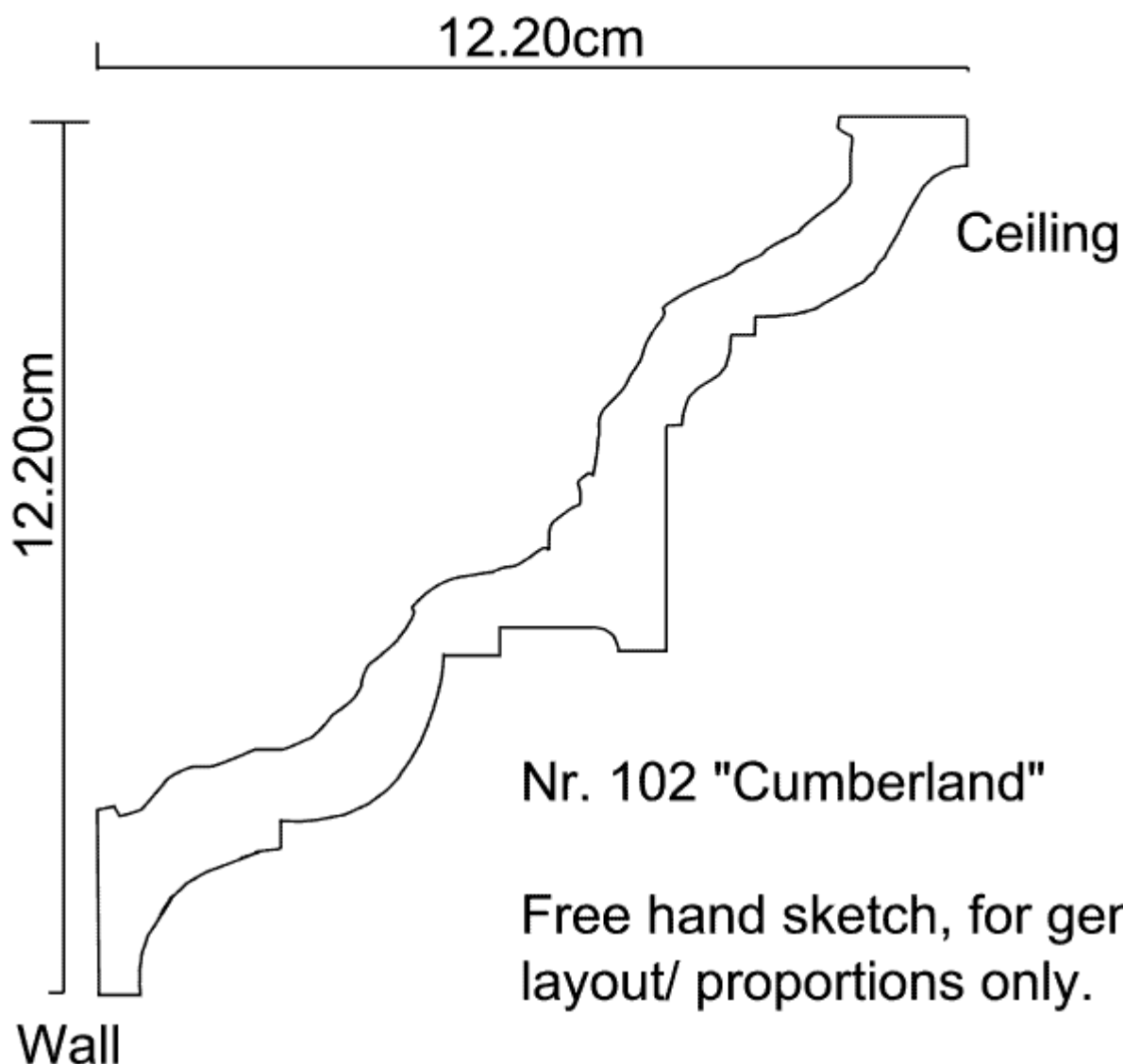
