

Cornice Nr. 130 “Hilton”



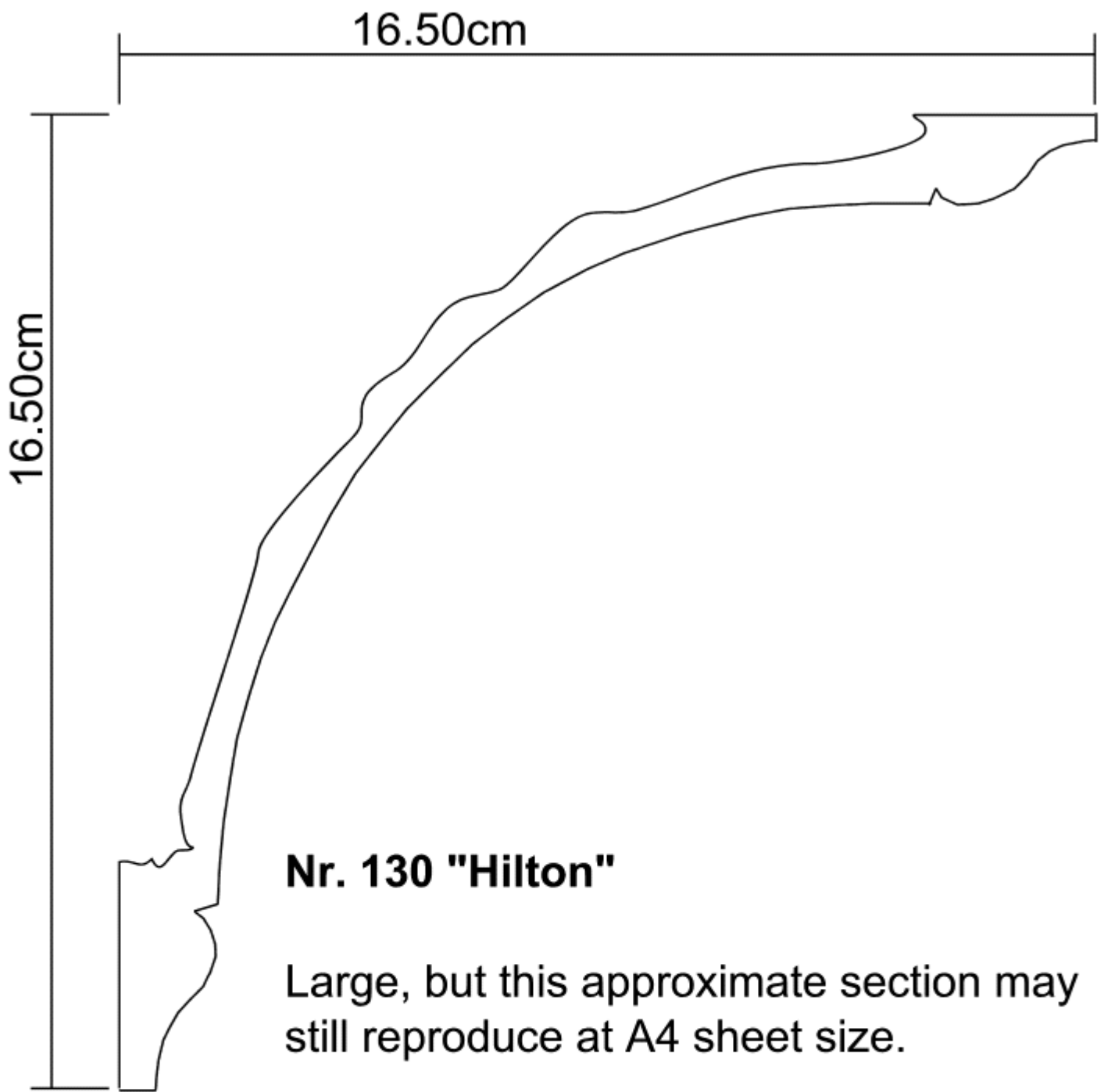
This photo' is a little misleading, but I cannot easily alter the proportions to properly reflect the actual quarter circle That really is the central cove section of this large cornice section.

Best really that one has the approximate cross section to refer to on page two of this document - hopefully that will better illustrate the proportions of this design.

Anyhow, this is a large section, it is best applied to an area with fairly high ceilings - unless of course, you are an adventurous designer and (like me) are prepared to take design risks!
