

Cornice Nr. 135 “Cotswold”

Despite this cornice not being of any apparent historic period, this is however a very popular cornice design, comfortably out selling many others.

It is very easily described as an “average sized” profile, it is also true to describe it as a modern cross section, really suitable for homes or premises with a lower ceiling.

The unusually long length might also give some economy in fitting and jointing.

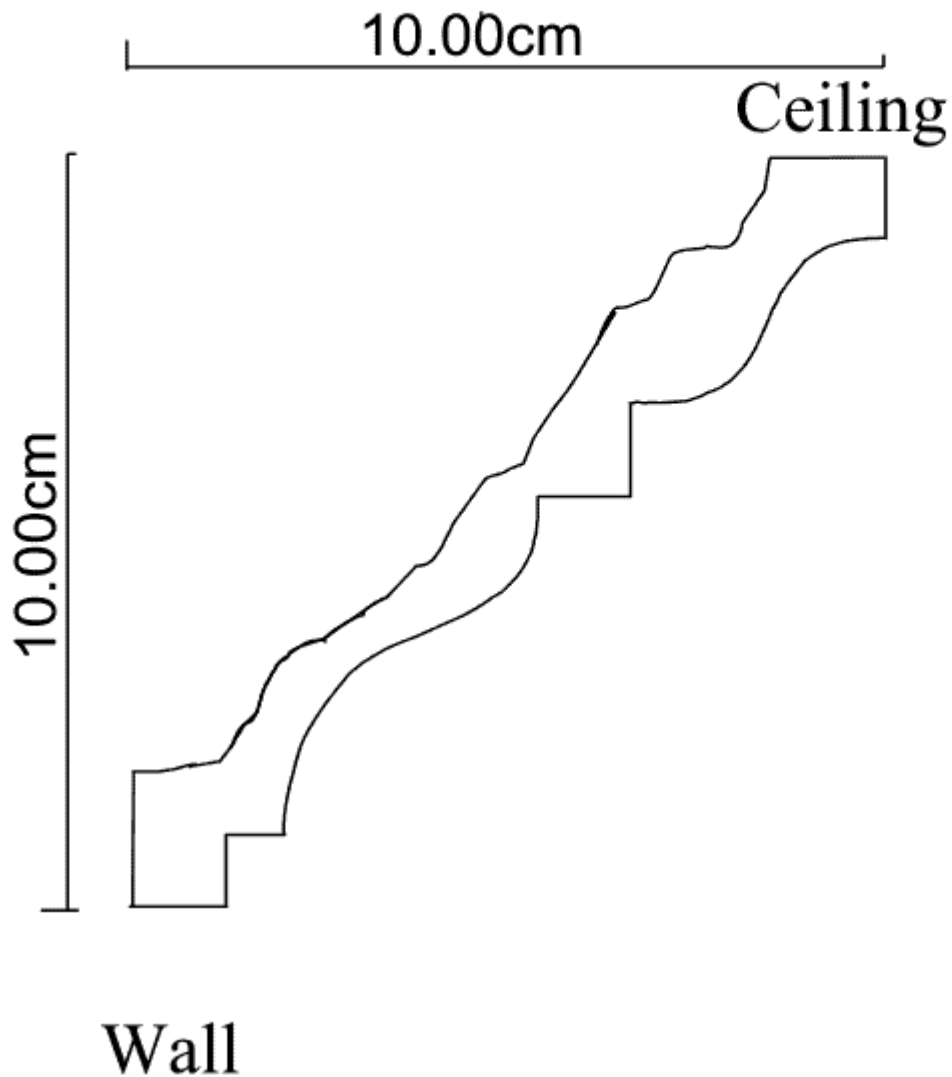


Projection 100mm. (c.4”)
