

**Cornice Nr. 150 “Heath”  
(Early Victorian in Style)**



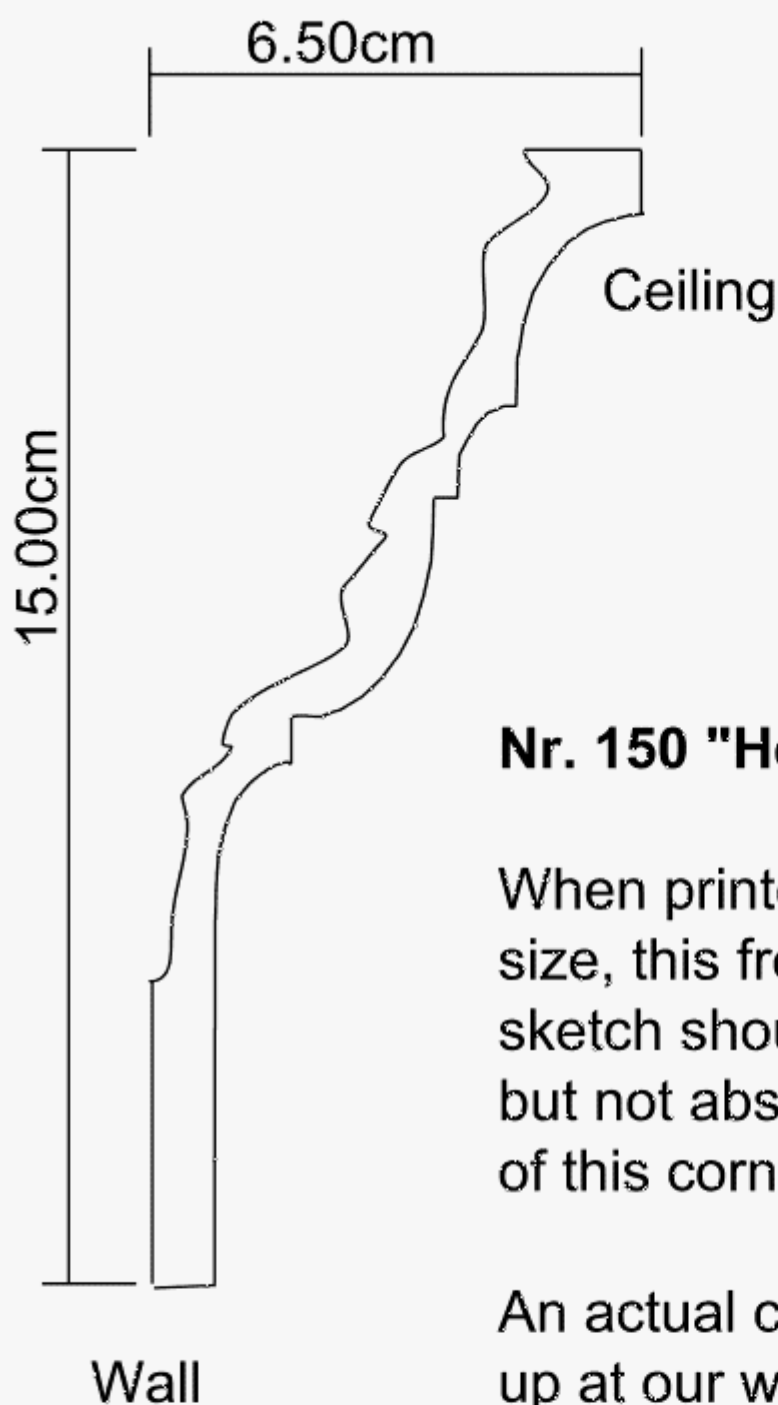
A plain, simple but absolutely authentic cornice design. This one is actually early Victorian - replicated exactly from a very large home in the West Riding of Yorkshire.

We believe the date to be 1830, but because of it's fairly small size and scale, this pattern would fit very well into more modern premises. Please do note that this cornice came from the very upper floor levels of this big house.

There is also another design of similar dimensions and period, but more simple and angular. This is waiting to be catalogued and will probably acquire the number 165.
