

CORNICE NR. 155 “TUDOR”

No, it's not authentically Tudor at all - but it does seem Tudor in “feel” and actually look Tudor in cross section to me.

What this cornice is very useful for in the most useful and practical sense is the very small depth dimension from the ceiling. This could be very useful where a high window approaches to within 50mm (2”) of the ceiling.

It is also useful where cornice is wanted in a low ceilinged room or simply where someone particularly likes this design or requires a design of this proportion or design.

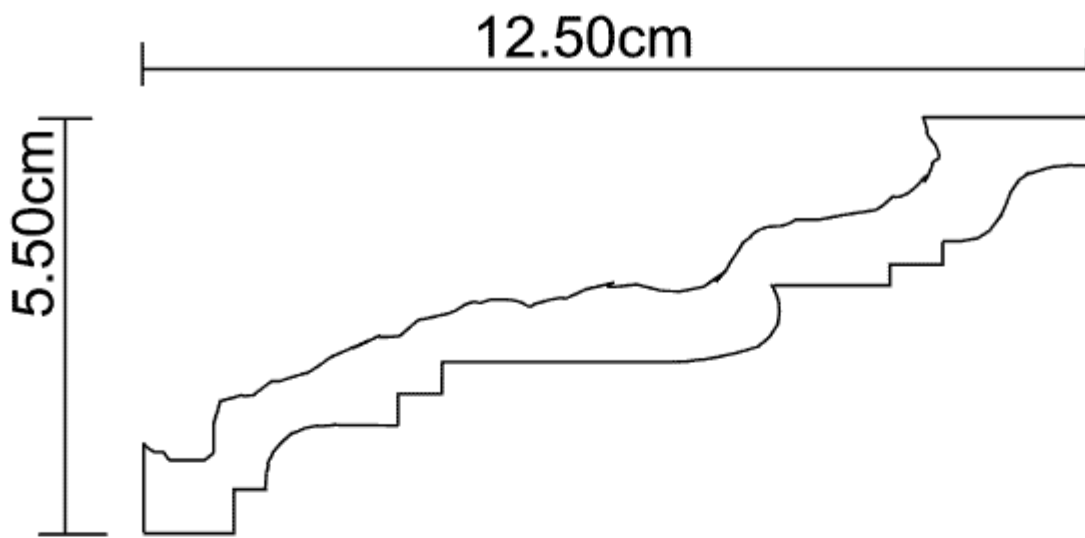
The design is, in truth one designed to accord with the style of “small town North America” at the turn of the 19th / 20th. Centuries -was commissioned by Parc Eurodisney and installed in France during 1991.
