

**Cornice Nr. 158 “Large Brindley”
(Modern Stepped Design)**



This one is an unmistakably, absolutely and utterly modern, bang up to date “today” cornice design.

Recall also the point made on page two that in many circumstances you might choose and be able to invert / turn over this particular design.

Until we can make time to improve upon it, we unfortunately only have this (above) illustration. This picture is a bit misleading as, in my view it “stretches” the moulding - in other words the image needs to be squashed a bit.

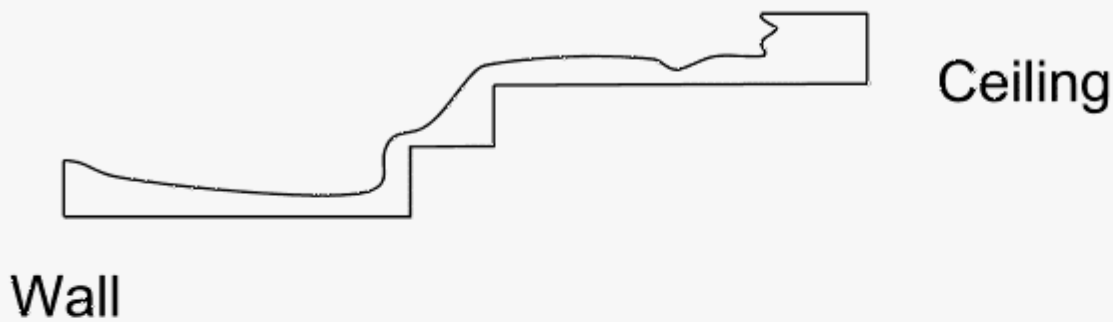
Please note the projection and depth figures below, or (perhaps) better still review the half size cross sectional drawing on page two of this document.

Projection 215mm. (c.8.5”)

Depth 55mm. (c.2”)

Length of Cast 3600mm. (12’0”)

Nr. 158 "Large Brindley"

This (approximate) sketch is half full size when reproduced at A4 size.

This cross section can (unusually) be inverted, that is to say you could, if you wish or chose to turn this design "upside down" to suit your design requirements.

For your information this cornice is, as illustrated here 215mm projection off of the wall and 55mm down from the ceiling.
