

Cornice Nr. 164 “Gothic”

(High Victorian in style)



Also a very new cornice design. Production of this cornice only began in early 2006. This design is also from the century before last, being an absolutely accurate reproduction that existing in a Spanish style restaurant in Deansgate, Manchester.

This is a plain cross section, but very undercut indeed. It is unique in our plain designs in needing a flexible silicone production mould. Sorry about the poor photograph, but this is a difficult cornice to “snap”.

As one can see from the dimensions below, this pattern is fairly large and will therefore be very suitable for large rooms and certainly areas with high ceilings.
